BRF1(Butyrate response factor 1) is a probable regulatory protein involved in regulating the response to growth factors. BRF1 contains 2 C3H1-type zinc fingers.

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to N-terminal residues of human BRF1(Butyrate response factor 1)
