IFNAR2(Interferon-alpha/beta receptor beta chain) is the receptor for interferons alpha and beta. Isoform 1 and isoform 3 are directly involved in signal traduction due to their interaction with the TYR kinase, JAK1. Isoform 1 also interacts with the transcriptional factors, STAT1 and STAT2. Both forms are potent inhibitors of type I IFN activity.

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to C-terminal residues of human IFNAR2 (Interferon-alpha/beta receptor beta chain precursor)
