

Anti-OLFM4(olfactomedin 4) Polyclonal Antibody

Description:

OLFM4 (olfactomedin 4) was originally cloned from human myeloblasts and found to be selectively expressed in inflamed colonic epithelium. OLFM4 (olfactomedin 4) is a member of the olfactomedin-related protein family. The exact function of this gene has not yet been determined.

Species: Human

Storage and Stability: at -20oC

Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to N-terminal residues of human OLFM4 (olfactomedin 4 precursor)

Storage buffer:

This antibody is stored in PBS, 0.01% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

Preparation:

Purified by antigen-specific affinity chromatography.
