

Anti-PRBP-I(Plasma retinol-binding protein I) Polyclonal Antibody

Description:

The RBP delivers retinol from the liver stores to the peripheral tissues. In plasma, the RBP-retinol complex interacts with transthyretin, this prevents its loss by filtration through the kidney glomeruli.

Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to N-terminal residues of chicken PRBP-I (Plasma retinol-binding protein I)

Storage buffer:

This antibody is stored in PBS, 0.01% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

Purified by antigen-specific affinity chromatography.
