## Description:

Pink1 (Serine/threonine kinase PINK1, mitochondrial) protects against mitochondrial dysfunction during cellular stress, potentially by phosphorylating mitochondrial proteins. It is highly expressed in testis, lower levels in brain, heart, lung, liver and kidney. Pink1 belongs to the Ser/Thr protein kinase family.

## Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to N-terminal residues of mouse Pink1(Serine/threonine kinase PINK1, mitochondrial precursor)
