## Description:

The SytVI (Synaptotagmin VI) may be involved in Ca(2+)-dependent exocytosis of secretory vesicles through Ca(2+) and phospholipid binding to the C2 domain or may serve as Ca(2+) sensors in the process of vesicular trafficking and exocytosis. It belongs to the synaptotagmin family and contains 2 C2 domains.

Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic phospho-peptide corresponding to C-terminal residues of human SytVI (Synaptotagmin VI)
