

Anti-TTC11(Tetratricopeptide repeat protein 11)Polyclonal Antibody

Description:

The TTC11(Tetratricopeptide repeat protein 11)promotes the fragmentation of the mitochondrial network and its perinuclear clustering. It can induce cytochrome c release from the mitochondrion to the cytosol, ultimately leading to apoptosis.It interacts with DNM1L.

Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to N-terminal residues of human TTC11(Tetratricopeptide repeat protein 11)
