

Anti-STATIP1(Stat3-interacting protein) Polyclonal Antibody

STATIP1(Stat3-interacting protein) regulates the ligand-dependent activation of Stat3, potentially by serving as a scaffold protein that promotes the interaction between Janus kinases and their Stat3 substrate.

Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to C-terminal residues of human STATIP1(Stat3-interacting protein)
