ANGPTL4(Angiopoietin-related protein 4) may exert a protective function on endothelial cells through an endocrine action. ANGPTL4 is predominantly expressed in adipose tissue and is strongly up-regulated by fasting in white adipose tissue and liver. ANGPTL4 contains 1 fibrinogen C-terminal domain.

Immunogen/Specificity:

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to N-terminal residues of mouse ANGPTL4(Angiopoietin-related protein 4 precursor)
