



Elk-1 (Phospho-Ser389) Antibody

Species: Human, Mouse and Rat

Quantity: 100ug

Concentration: 100ug/100ul

Storage and Stability: Store at -20°C/1 year

Immunogen: The antiserum was produced against synthesized phosphopeptide derived from human Elk-1 around the phosphorylation site of serine 389 (P-R-SP-P-A).

Specificity: Elk-1 (phospho-Ser389) antibody detects endogenous levels of Elk-1 only when phosphorylated at serine 389.

Tested application: IHC

Application Notes: Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg²⁺ and Ca²⁺), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

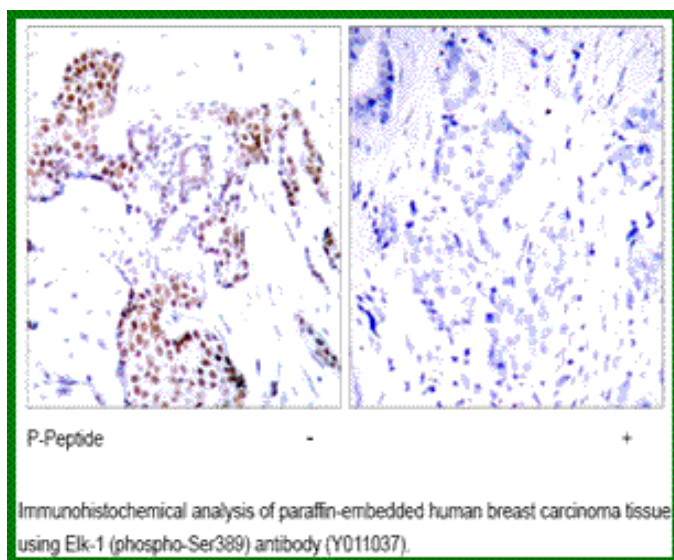
Raised In: Rabbit

Purity : The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific phosphopeptide. The antibody against non-phosphopeptide was removed by chromatography using non-phosphopeptide corresponding to the phosphorylation site.

Storage buffer: IHC: 1:50~1:100

Form: Liquid
